

Notice to individuals pursuant to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) regarding the processing of personal data¹

- **Purpose of personal data processing**

Organisation and implementation of the event marking the 25th anniversary of the Energy Agency: a Ceremonial academy entitled "Experience of the past, vision of the future", documentation of the event, photography and filming of the event, issuing public statements regarding the event and informing the public after the event, informing the public about similar or other events of the Energy Agency and providing any information and other materials related to the event, general promotion of the activities or operations of the Energy Agency.

- **Legal basis for the processing of personal data**

Article 6(1)(a) and 6(1)(e) of the General Data Protection Regulation and Article 93 of the Personal Data Protection Act (ZVOP-2)

- **Explanation of legitimate interests: /**
- **Categories of individuals to whom the personal data in the collection relate:**

Individuals who are invited or register or participate in an event.

- **Types of personal data in the collection:**

The following data are processed: Personal name, telephone number, e-mail address, employer details, details of field of work, position, function, details of participation in the event, and photographs and videos of the event or event participants, all in accordance with the principle of minimum data processing.

- **Users or categories of users of personal data²**

There are no external users, with the exception of users of photographs and videos of the event, which may be published publicly as part of reporting on the event and on the Energy Agency's website and social networks, in promotional and educational materials and at other events, workshops and presentations related to the work of the Energy Agency.

- **Information on transfers of personal data to a third country or international organisation**

Data is not transferred to third countries or international organisations.

- **Period for which the personal data will be stored, or, if that is not possible, the criteria used to determine that period**

One year after the event, except for photographs and videos, which will be stored until consent is withdrawn or until they are no longer relevant for the general promotional activities of the Energy Agency. Photographs and videos that are no longer used or are no longer suitable for publication will be deleted or removed from all communication channels of the Energy Agency.

²Point (9) of Article 4 of the General Regulation

- **Information on the existence of an individual's rights to request access to personal data and the correction or deletion of personal data or restriction, or the existence of the right to object to processing and the right to data portability:**

An individual may request access to personal data relating to them and, where the conditions are met in accordance with the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation, the right to rectification, objection, erasure or restriction of processing.

- **Information on the right to withdraw consent where processing is based on consent**

Individuals may withdraw their consent to receive notifications about Energy Agency events and other information at any time.

- **Information about**

- whether the provision of personal data is **a legal or contractual obligation**: NO
- whether **the individual is required to provide personal data and what the consequences are if they do not provide it**: Yes, otherwise they cannot attend the event and receive notifications and other information.
